AUSTIN LOCATIONS (100 PTS)

This iconic Texas building is surrounded by 22 acres of grounds scattered with statues and monuments.

On the west side of the building is a sculpture dedicated to Spanish War Veterans. When was it erected?

1951

This museum houses the personal papers donated by the 36th President of the United States.

Here you will find a replica of San Lorenzo. How much does it weigh?

This stadium has the capacity to seat 100,119, making it the largest stadium in the Big 12 Conference.

Near the northwest corner you will find a sculpture of a man signaling "Hook 'em Horns." When was this sculpture dedicated?

Sept. 18, 1999

Formerly the Mansion at Judges' Hill, this 1800s building has gone from being a private home to a boutique hotel.

Found to the right of the entrance you'll find an Austin Landmark plaque. What is the name of the house listed?

Goodall Wooten

Established in 1876 and named for Governor Elisha Pease, this elementary school is the oldest continuously operating school in the state.

At the front of the school is a plaque in honor of which principal from 1892-1933?

T.A. Brown

This center's mission is to procure, preserve, present and provide the historical records that make up Austin's unique story.

What company made the awning covering the entrance?

The Chism Company

Designed by Nicholas Clayton, this cathedral was his first church and independent commission.

AWW

Six 29-foot iconic columns span the front porch of this mansion designed by Abner Cook.

Located on the southeast corner and facing Colorado St., what word is engraved in pink granite?

TEAM NAME

Between 1950 and the early 1970s, this park functioned as a parking lot. Returning it to its original purpose began in 1976 as part of the U.S. Bicentennial celebration.

Here you will find a large sculpture named "Blackbird." On the sculpture's informational sign it states "Blackbird exists to bring...." what?

Good Cheer

This skyscraper stands 515 feet tall with 33 floors, making it the fourth tallest building in Austin.

The painted guitar located on the west side of the building is named...what?

Vibrancy

This courthouse complex occupies a full city block and contains eight courtrooms and ten judges' chambers.

Located near the main entrance, carved into the building, is the name of what US President?

Barack Obama

Named after actress Esther Williams, this comedic act has been called the Texas answer to SNL.

Cheshire Cat

Up until the bar's appearance on "Diners, Drive-Ins and Dives," this joint's burgers had been 6th Street's best-kept secret.

AUSTIN PHOTOS (100 PTS)

Take a photo with the monumental 35-foot tall bronze star, the highlight of the Lone Star Plaza, around which the six flags of Texas fly on 50-foot tall flagpoles.

Bullock Museum

Originally intended as a vaudeville venue, this theater was named the Majestic and opened on October 11, 1915.

Paramount Theater

This memorial consists of a fountain set in a three-tiered semicircular granite pool, with a large bronze sculpture rising above the water, backed by a limestone wall.

Littlefield Fountain

Titled 'Austin', it's a 2,715-square-foot stone building with luminous colored glass windows, a totemic wood sculpture, and fourteen black and white marble panels.

Blanton Museum

This restaurant's Mad Dog Margaritas made such an impression on Guy Clark that he thought about them while in Dublin.

Texas Chili Parlor

The central rotunda is filled with portraits of all the past presidents of the Republic of Texas and governors of the State of Texas. Take a photo with the portrait of Texas' first female governor.

Miriam A. Ferguson

This iconic building houses the bells of the Knicker Carillon and was originally designed to be a library.

UT Tower

Using old whiskey bottles and jam jars, this famous BBQ sauce began by being hand-bottled, each makeshift container corked with a jalapeño.

Stubbs BBQ

This museum was founded in 1984 to share the art and culture of Mexico with Texas. Snap a photo in front of the mural on the north side of the building.

Mexic-Arte Museum

In the heart of Austin's (in)famous 6th St. lies the city's most curious and mysterious gift shop. In the back of the shop is what some call Austin's best kept secret...

Museum of the Weird

This statue is of the first African-American congresswoman to come from the deep South and the first woman ever elected to the Texas Senate. Artist Bruce Wolfe captured this civil rights activist's personality, down to the way she held her spectacles.

Barbara Jordan

This monument depicts the contributions of African-American Texans to our great state, from slavery, to reconstruction, to the Civil Rights movement, to modern times.

African-American History Memorial

The woman who saved Austin. This bronze statue commemorates the woman who fired a cannon to stop the transfer of state archives by Republic of Texas President Sam Houston in 1842.

Angelina Eberly

In 1993, the Sound Exchange record store commissioned this album cover to be muralized on their exterior wall.

Jeremiah the Innocent

A throwback to the taco stands of the 60's, this fast-casual taco drive-thru sports colorful yellow flowers.
